

Glass and Ceramics

The working group's triennial program was discussed during the business meeting in The Hague and in a subsequent mailing to all members. The following initiatives were agreed on.

A. Glass and ceramics conservation training

Information about training programs in glass and ceramics conservation and the subjects of student research projects and dissertations will be collected and made available to members.

B. Bibliography

A critical bibliography on glass and ceramics conservation literature, including unpublished theses, will be created and maintained.

C. Research on glass deterioration

A network of members interested in the subject of glass deterioration will be established for the purpose of better information sharing and collaboration on experimental projects.

D. Networking on composite materials of glass, ceramics and metals

An exchange with the metals working group has been established whereby members from both groups with an interest in the study and conservation of composite materials may share expertise.

E. Interim meeting

An interim meeting will be held in Nova Gorica, Slovenia in 2007.
